## The number 1 thing I learned as Boy Scout in life!

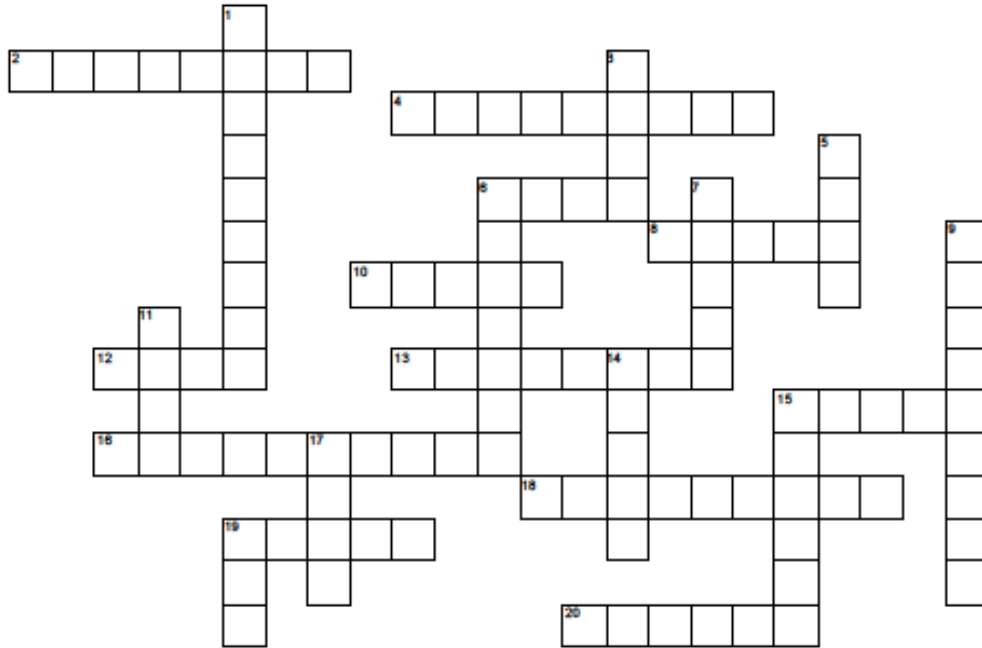

# Red Velvet Cheesecake Bites



Yields: 28

Prep time: 0 hours 15 minutes

Total time: 2 hours 0 minutes

Ingredients:

1 box red velvet cake mix, plus ingredients called for on the box

2 (8-oz.) blocks of cream cheese, softened

1/2 c. powdered sugar

2 tbsp. heavy cream

1 tsp. pure vanilla extract

Directions:

1.) Preheat the oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit and line a muffin pan with cupcake liners. Prepare red velvet cake batter according to the box directions. Divide batter among liners and bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, 18 to 20 minutes. Let cool completely. Break 4 cupcakes into small crumbs. Save remaining cakes for another use.

2.) In a large bowl using a hand mixer, beat cream cheese and powdered sugar until light and fluffy. Add heavy cream and vanilla and beat until stiff peaks form.

3.) Line a large baking sheet with parchment paper. Using a small cookie scoop, scoop cream cheese mixture into balls and place on prepared baking sheets. Transfer to the freezer to chill, 1 hour.

## History of Valentine's Day

Valentine's Day is celebrated annually on February 14. It originated as a Western Christian feast day honoring early Christian martyrs named Saint Valentine and is recognized as a significant cultural, religious, and commercial celebration of romance and love in many regions of the world.

There are a number of martyrdom stories associated with various Valentines connected to February 14.

According to one account, Valentine's Day is connected to the imprisonment of Saint Valentine of Rome for ministering to Christians persecuted under the Roman Empire in the third century. It is reported that Saint Valentine restored sight to the daughter of his jailer and legends claim he wrote the jailer's daughter a letter signed "Your Valentine" as a farewell before his execution.

Another account comes from a legend associated with Valentine of Rome. Emperor Claudius II wanted to recruit soldiers for the Roman army and prohibited young men from marrying, in case homesickness for wives, homes and families should affect their ability to meet military needs. The legend reports Valentine of Rome performed secret marriage rites for young men and women, defying the emperor's decree.

The day became associated with romantic love in the 14th and 15th centuries when notions of courtly love flourished, apparently by association with the "lovebirds" of early spring. In 18th-century England, it grew into an occasion in which couples expressed their love for each other by presenting flowers, offering candy, and sending greeting cards (known as "valentines").

Valentine's Day symbols that are used today include the heart-shaped outline, doves, and the figure of the winged Cupid. Since the 19th century, handwritten valentines have given way to mass-produced greeting cards. Saint Valentine's Day is not a public holiday in any country, however, is celebrated throughout the world.

In the United States, about 190 million Valentine's Day cards are sent each year, not including the hundreds of millions of cards school children exchange. To follow tradition,  Clubhouse is sending you.
